

Pulse output mode

The HRI supports 2 different pulse output modes via 2 cables

Mode B4 (Standard)	Used only for pulse collectors with uses one pulse input	l1: Balanced pulses 1)
		l2: Error status ²⁾
Mode B2		l1: Forward pulses
		l2: Backward pulses

^{1]} Backward pulses are balanced by suppressing an identical number of forward pulses.
